The NEC Group has a systematic approach to Fire Safety which is aligned to our general arrangements for Health and Safety Management and which is designed to ensure compliance with all applicable fire safety legislation, thus allowing for continuous improvement and providing assurance to those who either work at or visit our venues.

Our approach includes:

- **Acknowledging that the management of Fire Safety is a critical business activity**
- **The continuous development and promotion of a relevant and consistent Fire Safety Management System**
- **Providing suitably qualified expert resource and training to assist the business in developing and applying its Fire Safety policies and systems**
- **Having clear plans and accountabilities for continuous improvement in our Fire Safety Management Systems**
- **Encouraging communication with colleagues, clients, service partners and visitors on relevant matters relating to fire safety and responding appropriately to issues raised by those groups**
- **Monitoring and reporting on Fire Safety performance on a regular basis**
- **Ensuring that timely corrective and preventative action is taken to address Fire Safety issues that arise**

The NEC Group has a responsibility for Fire Safety within our venues and requires the support of our colleagues, clients, service partners and visitors to achieve and maintain high standards of Fire Safety.
